Position Summary: Horizons at Foote is looking for an experienced, dedicated, nurturing, and enthusiastic teacher with the ability to foster a lifelong love of learning in children. The successful candidate will be a team player who has experience teaching a wide range of abilities and extending the curriculum to meet the needs of all students. In addition, this person will have a strong commitment to the Horizons at Foote mission and interest in being involved in our community during the six-week summer enrichment program and through participation in year-round events. This position requires an ongoing commitment to the Horizons students and families and a keen interest in professional development for desired areas of growth. The ideal candidate will learn and grow with the organization. We are planning for in-person programming using applicable CDC guidelines.

General Description:

- Lead classroom educator for approximately 16 students during a six-week summer academic and enrichment program
- Build strong, consistent, and mutually respectful relationships with students and their families
- Responsible for planning and instruction of different subject areas using a wide range of teaching aids
- Write lesson plans, teach lessons and provide evaluative feedback
- Maintain attendance records in coordination with assistant teacher
- Work with and guide the assistant teacher; oversee and supervise assigned interns and volunteers
- Attend all field trips, participate daily in meals with students, assist students during swim
 lessons, attend our annual family night, faculty meetings, and other duties as assigned
- Attend one week of orientation and set up prior to the start of the program
- Attend health and allergy trainings; awareness of class' allergies and health statuses, communication with TA, classroom interns and volunteers to ensure awareness
- Use ParentSquare platform as well as phone calls to regularly communicate with students' families
