Position Summary: Horizons at Foote is looking for a nurturing, adaptable person who understands the developmental and cognitive needs of children and who can teach collaboratively in a creative, cooperative environment. The successful candidate will have experience with teaching to a wide range of abilities as well as with extending cultural curriculum to meet the needs of our students. In addition, he or she will have a commitment to our mission and an interest in being involved in our community through participation in program-wide activities. We are planning for in-person programming using applicable CDC guidelines.

General Description:

- Experience teaching enrichment classes preferably elementary and middle school
- Deep commitment to diversity and introducing our students to BIPOC artists, musicians and athletes through an array of cultural and monumental works, curriculum and community-inspired pieces
- Develop and teach enrichment lessons based in art history, music theory and sports education curriculum
- Collaborate and plan with other enrichment teachers for HORIZON's STRONG Family Event and Field Day
- Work with and guide the assistant teacher; oversee and supervise assigned interns and volunteers
- Attend all field trips, participate daily in meals with students, attend our annual family night, faculty meetings, and other duties as assigned
- Attend one week of orientation and set up prior to the start of the program
- Attend health and allergy trainings; awareness of class' allergies and health statuses, communication with TA, classroom interns and volunteers to ensure awareness
