**Position Summary:** Horizons at Foote is looking for Interns and volunteers that can commit to a regular schedule. Please give careful thought to your availability during this time. Interning and volunteering for Horizons is a serious commitment that should be met with a sense of professionalism and dedication. **Interns must work for the entire program, full days (M-F 8:05am - 3:05 pm).** In addition, this person will have a strong commitment to the Horizons at Foote mission and interest in being involved in our community during the six-week summer enrichment program and through participation in year-round events. This position requires an ongoing commitment to the Horizons students and families and a keen interest in professional development for desired areas of growth. The ideal candidate will learn and grow with the organization. We are planning for in-person programming using applicable CDC quidelines.

## **General Description:**

- Work with head teacher in a classroom of approximately 16 students during a six-week summer academic and enrichment program
- Develop and lead small group activities
- Prepare and gather materials for lessons and projects
- Monitor students closely and carefully at recess and during specials
- Build strong, consistent, and mutually respectful relationships with students
- Attend all field trips, participate daily in meals with students, assist students during swim
  lessons, attend our annual family night, faculty meetings, and other duties as assigned
- Attend one week of orientation and set up prior to the start of the program
- Adhere to "no cell phone" policy while working with students
